




**TAKE NOTICE THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton intends to designate the exterior only of the building known municipally as 58 Victoria Street, in the Town of Milton, Regional Municipality of Halton, in the Province of Ontario, as being of historical and architectural value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O. 18.

**REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION:**

This gracious residence constructed in the late 1800's is built in true Victorian style, with steep pitches and gables, gingerbread trim and elongated, mullioned windows. The interior retains its original hardwood floors and carved woodwork, along with 12" deep mouldings. An original wooden staircase completes the period interior setting.
