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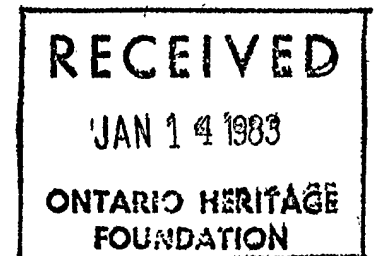

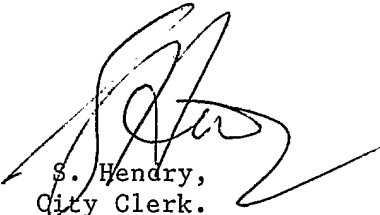

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY MUNICIPALLY KNOWN  
AS 565 WATER STREET IN THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH UNDER  
THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, 1974

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS  
AS FOLLOWS:

1. The hereinafter described property be and is hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest under the provisions of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 for the reasons hereinafter stated:

THE HARSTONE HOUSE (565 WATER STREET) - ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being the City of Peterborough, in the County of Peterborough and Province of Ontario and being composed of part of Lot Number 2 east of George Street and north of London Street according to Registered Plan Number 63 for the said City of Peterborough and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the south east angle of the said Lot Number 2:

THENCE NORTHERLY along the easterly limit of the said Lot which is also the westerly limit of Water Street 102 feet.

THENCE WESTERLY parallel with the southerly limit of the said Lot which is also the northerly limit of London Street 110.96 feet more or less to a lane shown on Registered Plan Number 63 for the said City of Peterborough;

THENCE SOUTHERLY parallel to the easterly limit of the said Lot along the eastern limit of the said lane to the southerly limit of the said Lot which is also the northern limit of London Street.

THENCE EASTERLY along the southern limit of the said Lot which is also the northern limit of London Street to the place of beginning.

REASON FOR DESIGNATION - One of the grandest of its era in the City, the house was designed by the noted Peterborough architect William Blackwell early in his career. It is a fine example of the Queen Anne style and has many interesting interior and exterior features, most notable of which is the magnificent stair hall. The house has undergone almost no alterations since its construction.
