TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Orillia intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 18 Peter Street North, as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

Reasons for the Proposed Designation

[St. James Court Apartments, 18 Peter Street North has been recommended for designation for architectural and historic reasons. It was built in 1906-07 by J. R. Eaton of Orillia and served the community as a Y.M.C.A. for a period of 75 years.]

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the City of Orillia before the 8th day of June, 1985.
