TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the
City of Orillia intends to designate the property, including
lands and buildings, known municipally as 58 Peter Street
North, as a property of architectural and historical value
or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974,
S.O. Chapter 122.

Reasons for the Proposed Designation

St. James Anglican Church has been recommended for designation
for architectural and historical reasons. This solid brick,
Gothic Revival Church, was designed by W.H. Croker and built
in 1891. The Sunday School addition was built in 1903. The
first religious services in Orillia were held on this site and
the present building is the third church on this location.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with
a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant
facts may be served on the Clerk of the City of Orillia before
the 30th day of August 1980.
