CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FLAMBOROUGH
NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL A PORTION OF
BY-LAW 80-118-H

On November 3rd, 1980, the Corporation of the Town of Flamborough passed By-law 80-119-H, being a By-law to designate the property municipally known as 24 Griffin Street, Waterdown, (Part Lot 16, Plan M-12 Township of Flamborough), under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974.

Since that time a portion of this property has been severed and sold. As the severed lot has no heritage significance it is no longer appropriate that it be designated as a heritage property.

Therefore under the authority of the Ontario Heritage Act, the Corporation of the Town of Flamborough proposes to pass a By-law to repeal the heritage designation on the severed property which is municipally known as 20 Griffin Street, Waterdown (Part Lot 16, Plan M-12).

Any person wishing to object to the removal of the heritage designation from the property known as 20 Griffin Street, should be so prior to May 25th, 1990. Submissions may be left with the Deputy Clerk at the municipal offices 163 Dundas Street West, Waterdown, Monday to Friday between 8:30 - 4:30.
