  -a good example of a turn of the century Gothic style brick church.
- (b) Ravenscourt, R.R. #4, Cobourg, Ontario, K9A 4J7, Part Lot 33, Conc. 1,
  -a mid 19th century Classical Revival Country House of Provincial significance.
- (c) Runlet Ltd.(The Old Daignault Farm House), H.R. Daignault, R.R. #6, Cobourg, Ontario, K9A 4J9, Part Lot 10, Conc. 2, -a classic example of a house built in the mid 1800's.

- (d) Cobourg, Ontario, K9A 4J9, Part Lot 16, Conc. 5, -a good example of a Neo-classical house of the 1830's.
- (e) Ball's Mill, Part Lot 7, Conc.

  -a good example of a mill in a Neo-classical style of the mid 19th century.
- (f) Mavis Bank, Gores Landing, Ontario, KOK 2EO, Part Lot 15, Conc. 9, -a good example of a Regency Cottage built in 1848.
