## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Glanbrook intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, S.O. Chapter 337.

Christ Church Anglican - Village of Woodburn as shown on Reg. Plan No's. 188 & 188A, part of lot 5, block 1, concession 2, Binbrook now Glanbrook.

## REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION

A well preserved structure built of stone in 1884 in the style of a typical English Country Church with the original side stain glass windows having pointed gothic arches with a pronounced keystone.

ANY PERSONS MAY, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Glanbrook notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Glanbrook shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
