TOWNSHIP OF FLAMBOROUGH

By-Law No. 78-21-H

Being a By-Law to designate 25 Mill St. N. Waterdown, a building of Historical and Architectural value.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act Chapter 122, Section 29 (6) R.S.O. 1975, as amended. The Counil may pass by-laws to designate a building of Historical and Architectural value.

WHEREAS a notice has been published three consecutive weeks in the Flamboro Review, indicating the intention of Council to designate 25 Mill Street North, Waterdown, as a building of Historical and Architectural value.

WHEREAS no objection was received to such designation NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLAMBOROUGH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That the Building at 25 Mill St. North, Waterdown is hereby designated a historical building, under the Ontario Heritage Act.
- That the reasons for designation are as follows:
 - The Hall was erected in 1857 and is an excellent example of the classical style of public stone buildings erected in Ontario during the first half of the 19th century. The features typifying the style are the general proportions of the whole building, including the roof the Georgian windows, the cupola and the double leaf front doors.
 - The Hall was the administrative and political (b) centre for the Township of East Flamborough for over 100 years.
 - That this by-law be published in the local newspaper forwarded to the Ontario Heritage Foundation and registered in the Registry Office in Hamilton.
