Decision

At its meeting of March 24, 2015, Vaughan City Council adopted the following recommendations from the above-noted report:

Recommendations

The Commissioner of Planning, Director of Development Planning, and Manager of Urban Design and Cultural Heritage recommend:

1. THAT the proposed demolition of the George Munshaw House, Designated Part IV under the *Ontario Heritage Act* through By-law 403-87, BE REFUSED; and
2. THAT staff be directed to continue to work with the applicant to incorporate the George Munshaw House into the approved Plan of Subdivision 19T-03V13.

The George Munshaw House is Designated Part IV (By-law 403-87) as per the *Ontario Heritage Act* R.S.O. 1990, c. O. 18 (the "Act"). Pursuant to the requirements of the Act, Council will also:

1. by copy of this Notice of Decision notify the Ontario Heritage Trust; and
2. shall publish its decision of March 24, 2015 in an upcoming edition of each of the *Thornhill Liberal* and *Vaughan Citizen* newspapers.

Right to Appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board

The Act provides the owner of the property may appeal Council's decision to refuse to permit the demolition to the Ontario Municipal Board within 30 days of receiving notice of decision.
