Decision

At its meeting of March 24, 2015, Vaughan City Council adopted the following recommendations from the above-noted report:

Recommendations

The Commissioner of Planning, Director of Development Planning, and Manager of Urban Design and Cultural Heritage recommend:

- THAT the proposed demolition of the George Munshaw House, Designated Part IV under the Ontario Heritage Act through By-law 403-87, BE REFUSED; and
- THAT staff be directed to continue to work with the applicant to incorporate the George Munshaw House into the approved Plan of Subdivision 19T-03V13.

The George Munshaw House is Designated Part IV (By-law 403-87) as per the *Ontario Heritage Act* R.S.O. 1990, c. O. 18 (the "Act"). Pursuant to the requirements of the Act, Council will also:
