## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TO:

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sudbury intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 38 Xavier Street, Sudbury, Ontario, as properties of architectural and/or historic value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, R.S.O. Chapter 122:

## Reasons for Proposed Designation

D'Youville Orphanage - this building was built as a separate school in 1894 and is one of Sudbury's oldest buildings. The orphanage has served to meet the needs of the community first as a separate school and now as an orphanage.

Any person may, prior to Tuesday, January 12, 1981, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Sudbury notice of his/her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reason for the objection and all relevant facts. Where such notice of objection has been received the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sudbury shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.
