TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings known municipally as the Canadian Pacific Railway Station, 10 John Street North, as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, Statutes of Ontario, 1974, Chapter 122, as amended.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION 10 JOHN STREET NORTH

(CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY STATION)

The Arnprior Canadian Pacific Station (built 1899-1900) was designed by the famous Montreal architect Edward Maxwell. This building was probably a prototype of similar stations in Almonte, Renfrew and Pembroke.

The Arnprior Canadian Pacific Station has historical significance as a local landmark which symbolizes Arnprior's turn of the century prosperity. It has architectural significance for the merits of its design and as work of Edward Maxwell.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Arnprior before the 30th day of January, 1981.
