



## BY-LAW NO. <u>77-161</u>

BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE VOELKER HOUSE IN THE CITY OF WATERLOO TO BE OF HISTORIC VALUE AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes Council of a municipality to designate property within the municipality to be of historic value or incerest;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the City of Waterloo deems it desirable to designate the Voelker house to be of historic value and interest insofar as this house, originally built in 1849, has retained most of its original form and is a combination of architectural influences from the Georgian, Classic and Gothic Periods;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the City of Waterloo has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29 (3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29 (5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The Voelker house located on lands described in Schedule "A", 1. attached hereto, is hereby designated to be of historic value and interest.
- This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo.
