## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO

BY-LAW NUMBER 79-188

BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE MUTUAL LIFE BUILDING IN THE CITY OF WATERLOO TO BE OF HISTORIC AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes Council of a municipality to designate property within the municipality to be of historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the City of Waterloo deems it desirable to designate the Mutual Life Building to be of historic and architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the City of Waterloo has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest, provided however that the existing fence abutting Union Street and King Street and the existing sign located on Lot 101, Registered Plan 385 are exempt from the designation contained herein.
- 2. Section 33(1) of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 shall apply only to the following exterior elevations of the Mutual Life Building:
  - (a) the North or King Street facade of the 1912 building, measuring approximately 110 feet in length;
  - (b) the East or Union Street facade of the 1912 and 1921 buildings, measuring approximately 200 feet in length;
  - (c) the front portion (nearest King Street) of the West facade of the 1912 building, measuring back approximately 60 feet from the front corner of the building.

3. By-law Number 79-127 is hereby repealed.

4. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo.

## SCHEDULE "A"

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Waterloo, in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo (formerly in the City of Waterloo, in the County of Waterloo) and Province of Ontario and being composed of Lot 103 and Parts of Lots 101, 102, 122, 123 and 124, Registered Plan 385 and Part of Caroline Street Closed (by By-law 57, see Instrument 1106) and designated as PART 1 on a Plan of Survey deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Waterloo North (No. 58) as Plan 58R-2880.
