

BY-LAW NO. 00-107

BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE LANDS AND PREMISES LOCATED AT 600 ERB STREET WEST, IN THE CITY OF WATERLOO, AND KNOWN AS THE RUMMELHARDT SCHOOL (KITCHENER-WATERLOO BILINGUAL SCHOOL), TO BE OF HISTORIC VALUE AND INTEREST

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, authorizes the Council of a municipality to designate lands and premises within the municipality to be of historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo deems it desirable to designate the structure known as the Rummelhardt School (Kitchener-Waterloo Bilingual School), located at 600 Erb Street West in the City of Waterloo;


AND WHEREAS the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo has caused notice of intention to designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990;

**THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF
WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The property described as Part of Lot 32, German Company Tract, City of Waterloo, Regional Municipality of Waterloo, designated as Parts 1, 3 and 4, Plan 58R-12454, and municipally known as 600 Erb Street West, Waterloo, is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest.
2. Section 33 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, shall apply to all facades of the original stone schoolhouse of the Rummelhardt School (Kitchener-Waterloo Bilingual School), described as Part of Lot 32, German Company Tract, City of Waterloo, Regional Municipality of Waterloo, designated as Parts 1, 3 and 4, Plan 58R-12454, and municipally known as 600 Erb Street West, Waterloo.
3. This By-Law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Waterloo.
