NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener intends to designate the property at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S. O. Chapter 122.

The subject property is located at 69 Biehn Drive and is owned by [REDACTED]

It is intended that in particular, the exterior stone walls and the stencilled ceiling in the main room of the David Weber House will be designated.

The designation described herein is recommended due to the fact that David Weber was an early Mennonite leader and founder of the Weber Church, which is now the Pioneer Christian Fellowship Church. In addition, the ceiling of the main room was painted by Joseph Moser, a prominent fresco artist in Upper Canada. In regard to architectural value, the David Weber House is a good example of a 1½ storey Waterloo Georgian stone structure.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Kitchener notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
