BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE RICHBER HOUSE, IN THE CITY OF WATERLOO, TO BE OF HISTORIC AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OR INTEREST. 5-24

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c.337, authorizes Council of a municipality to designate property within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the City of Waterloo deems it desirable to designate the property referred to hereinafter to be of historic and architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the City of Waterloo has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c.337;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c.337.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest.
- 2. Section 33(1) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c.337 shall apply only to the West, North and South facades, excluding the large window at the rear of the south side.

This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the City of Waterloo.

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SCHEDULE 'A'

PART OF LOT 363, REGISTERED PLAN 385 (JOHN HOFFMAN'S SURVEY), CITY OF WATERLOO

ALL AND SINGULAR THAT certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Waterloo, in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo (formerly the County of Waterloo), in the Province of Ontario, being composed of Part of Lot 363, Registered Plan 385, described as follows:

PREMISING that the southwesterly limit of the said Lot 363 has a bearing of North 51 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West and relating all bearings herein thereto;

SUBJECT to a Right-of-Way, at all times in common with those entitled thereto, over, along and upon the southeasterly 5.50 feet in perpendicular width of the hereinbefore described parcel extending 68 feet northeasterly from the southwesterly limit of said Lot 363.
