SCHEDULE TO A DOCUMENT GENERAL

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO

BY-LAW NO. 88-183

BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE OLD POST OFFICE,  
35 KING STREET NORTH, IN THE  
CITY OF WATERLOO, TO BE OF  
HISTORIC AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE AND  
INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act,  
R.S.O. 1980 authorizes Council of a municipality to  
designate property within the municipality to be of  
historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for The Corporation of the  
City of Waterloo deems it desirable to designate the Old  
Post Office, 35 King Street North, to be of historic and  
architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the City of Waterloo  
has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in  
accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act,  
R.S.O. 1980;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been  
served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of  
The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980.


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE  
CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto  
is hereby designated to be of historic and  
architectural value and interest.

2. Section 33 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 shall apply only to all four facades, the tower and the entire roofline of the Old Post Office.
3. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo.

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Waterloo, in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo and Province of Ontario and being composed of Lot 5, West of King Street and South of School Grounds according to Jacob C. and Elias Snider's Survey, Registered Plan No. 491 for the said City of Waterloo.
