BY-LAW NO. 97-10

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the City of Waterloo has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990;

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WATERLOO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated to be of historic value and interest.
- 2. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Waterloo.
