NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener intends to designate the property at the following municipal address as a property of historical value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S. O. Chapter 122.

The subject property is located at 37 Pinnacle Drive and is owned by [REDACTED]. It is intended that in particular, the exterior walls of the former Red Lion Inn as they existed in 1892, will be designated.

The designation described herein is recommended due to the fact that the Red Lion Inn had been an operating business over many years, and therefore played an important role in the development of lower Doon.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Kitchener notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
