OF THE

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KITCHERER

(Seing a By-law to designate part of the property municipally known as 43 Senton Street in the City of Kitchener as being of historical and architectural value)



REASONS FOR DESIGNATION

The designation described herein is recommended on historical and architectural grounds. The building stands on the size of the birthplace of former Frime Minister Walliam Lyon MacKensie King. It was constructed in 1928 as a Pentesontal church, and between 1968 and 1960, it boused the K-W Art Callery. The architect of this building was Mr. W. H. R. Schmalz who also designed the old Kitchsmar City Hall, and the Kitchsmar-Waterloo Collegiate.

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
