(Being a by-law to designate part of the property municipally known as 43 Schneider Avenue in the City of Kitchener as being of historic and architectural value)

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of
Kitchener has caused to be served on the owner of the lands and premises
known municipally as 43 Schneider Avenue in the City of Kitchener, and upon
the Ontario Heritage Foundation, a Notice of Intention to Designate as being
of historical and architectural value that part of the aforesaid real
property more particularly hereinafter described, and has caused such Notice
of Intention to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in
the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served upon the Clerk of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kitchener enacts as follows:

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION

The designation described herein has been made on historic and architectural grounds. The house was constructed in 1888 by Tobias and Mary Shantz and has been occupied ever since by various members of the Shantz family. The building is an example of the Italianate style and incorporates the following architectural features: wooden eaves, soffits and facia; decorative facia boards; shallow arched window openings with radiating voussoirs; wooden frames and double hung wooden sash; small semi-circular windows with radiating voussoirs, in the gable peaks; boxed eave return and paired decorative eave brackets.
