Re: 1. Notice of Intention - 1198 Highland Road West, Kitchener

I am writing to advise that due to an error by K-W Record Staff the Notice of Intention which Council directed to be published for 1198 Highland Road West did not appear in the newspaper on February 11, 1989. Since the Ontario Heritage Act states that the Notice must be published for three consecutive weeks, it will be necessary to reprint the Notice of Intention beginning on February 18, 1989. Consequently the last date for objecting to the designation is March 21, 1989. A copy of the revised Notice of Intention is attached for your information pursuant to Part 4, Section 29(3a) of the Ontario Heritage Act.

It should be stressed that this is not intended to deliberately prolong the designation process, but is necessary in order to comply with the provisions of the Act. If you have any further questions or concerns please call me at 741-2279.

NOTICE OF INTENTION

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener intends to designate the exterior of the original building and fieldstone addition at the following municipal address as being of historic and architectural significance, under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

1198 Highland Road West

The 2 storey farmhouse was constructed in the late 1850's as a 1 1/2 storey Ontario cottage, with a second storey and fieldstone addition added prior to 1880. The residence is considered to be representative of this community's agricultural heritage, and a method of fieldstone construction rare in the City.

All elevations of the farmhouse and the fieldstone addition are proposed for designation. Significant architectural features include: all fieldstone building fabric; brick voussoirs; double hung 2/2 sash; wooden window sills and frames; wooden door frames; and rooflines of both structures.

Any person may, before the 21st day of March, 1989 send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Kitchener notice of his or her objections to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. When a Notice of Objection has been received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a Hearing and report.
