NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener intends to designate the property at the following municipal address as a property of historical value under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S. O. Chapter 122.

The subject property is located at 787 King Street West, and is owned by the Waterloo County Board of Education. It is intended that in particular, the area in the foyer of the Kitchener-Waterloo Collegiate and Vocational School between the two pillars upon which the school's Rele of Honour listing the names of the war dead now stands, will be designated.

The Kitchener-Waterloo Collegiate and Vocational School is recommended for designation as a building of historical value in recognition of its 125 years of service to this community, its profound effect upon the lives of many of our distinguished citizens, and in recognition of the efforts of the men and women who dedicated their lives to the education of the students who attended this school.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Kitchener notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
