AND IN THE MATTER OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATION IN THE CITY OF KITCHENER IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO

NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener has passed by-law number 80-21-P to designate the following property as being of architectural and historic value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122:

The existing exterior walls of the Free Church and the graveyards and the lands located within the boundary of the subject property are being designated. The subject property consists of Lots 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, small lots on the north side of Peter Horning's Tract, Bloomingdale Road and is owned by the City of Kitchener.

The Free Church is being designated not only for its architectural value, but also for its unique historical background. The Free Church, built in 1848, is reportedly the second oldest church in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo. In addition, there are few structures of early brick construction (1840-1850) that exist which possess the Georgian design exhibited by the Free Church.
