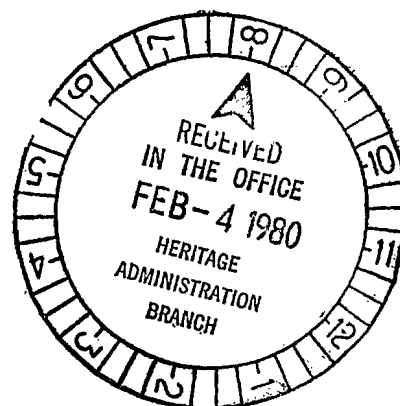

NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of  
Kitchener has passed by-law number 80-21-P to designate the  
following property as being of architectural and historic value  
under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter  
122:

The existing exterior walls of the Free Church and the  
graveyards and the lands located within the boundary of  
the subject property are being designated. The subject  
property consists of Lots 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, small lots  
on the north side of Peter Horning's Tract, Bloomingdale  
Road and is owned by the City of Kitchener.

The Free Church is being designated not only for its  
architectural value, but also for its unique historical  
background. The Free Church, built in 1848, is reportedly  
the second oldest church in the Regional Municipality of  
Waterloo. In addition, there are few structures of early  
brick construction (1840-1850) that exist which possess  
the Georgian design exhibited by the Free Church.

## CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KITCHENER

(Being a by-law to designate property fronting onto Bloomingdale Road in the City of Kitchener as being of architectural and historical value or interest)

WHEREAS section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kitchener has caused to be served on the owner of the lands and premises fronting onto Bloomingdale Road, in the City of Kitchener and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kitchener enacts as follows:

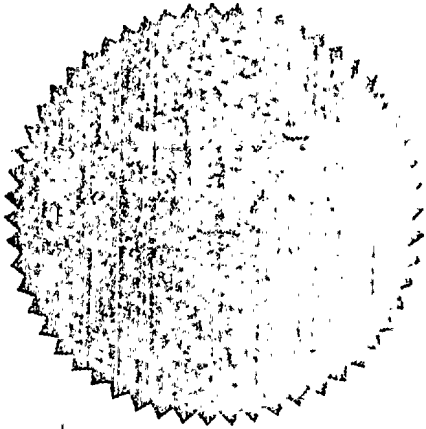
1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property fronting onto Bloomingdale Road in the City of Kitchener, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.
2. The City Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general
