THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF SCARBOROUGH

BY-LAW NUMBER 22104

being a by-law to repeal the Ontario Heritage Act designation on Mammoth Hall located on the north side of Ormerod Street

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a municipality to repeal a by-law designating a property;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Scarborough has caused a notice of intention to repeal the designation upon the owners of land and premises known as Mammoth Hall, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and has caused such notice of intention to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF SCARBOROUGH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law Number 21183 is repealed.
