TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Fenelon Falls intends to designate the buildings and land and a spiral staircase at the following municipal address as properties of architectural and historical value and interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

(1) C.N.R. Railway Station, Lindsay Street:

Reasons for proposed designation:
Probably dating from 1889, with additions and alterations around 1910 and late, the old G.T.R. station is a fine example of railway station architecture. A plain, frame building, the station represents an important part of the village's historical development as is evidenced by the Village seal which displays a steam engine. This well known landmark provided an important link for industry and communication in earlier years and should be preserved as a vital part of the village's history.

19 Short Street:

Reasons for proposed designation:
Date of construction: Circa 1900.
The only surviving spiral staircase in the Village of Fenelon Falls. Although not readily visible to the public eye, the intricate craftsmanship required to produce stair railings, spindles, steps and baseboard is important to the historical and architectural aspect of our Village.


COMPLETE SPIRAL STAIRCASE (steps, risers
