

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE
OF FENELON FALLS
BY-LAW #83-20

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS
103 LINDSAY STREET AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL
VALUE AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974,
authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws
to designate the RAILWAY STATION to be of architectural
and historical interest and value; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of
Fenelon Falls has caused to be served on the owner of the
lands and premises known as Canadian National Railway Station
at 103 Lindsay Street, and upon the Ontario Heritage
Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid
real property and has caused such notice of intention to be
published in the same newspaper having general circulation
in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;
and


WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has
been served on the Clerk of the municipality;


THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Fenelon
Falls enacts as follows;

1. There is designated as being of architectural and
historical value and interest the real property
known as Canadian National Railway Station at 103
Lindsay Street, more particularly described in
Schedule A hereto.
2. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to
cause a copy of this by-law to be registered
against the property described in Schedule A
hereto in the property land registry office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of
this by-law to be served on the owner of the afore-
said property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation
and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law
to be published in the same newspaper having general
circulation in the municipality once for each of
three consecutive weeks.
