Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Pakenham notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pakenham shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
