TOWNSHIP OF RAMSAY

IN THE MATTER of THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, 1980, R S O, Chapter 337, AND IN THE MATTER of the building known municipally as the former S S # 9 schoolhouse, situated on Part of lot 16 in the seventh concession of the Township of Ramsay.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the council of the Corporation of the Township of Ramsay on the 4th. day of April, 1984, decided to designate the building known municipally as the former S S # 9 schoolhaouse, situated on Part of Lot 16 in the seventh concession of the Township of Ramsay, as a building of historical value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, R S O, Chapter 337.

SHORT STETEMENT OF REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION

This building known as the S S # 9 schoolhouse is an excellant example of a rural schoolhouse of the mid — nineteenth century and is unique in being the only stone schoolhouse in the township. This rectangular one and one half stoney building is typical in having three large windows on each side and a central door flanked by two large windows on the front facade.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days (30) of the 6th. day of June, 1984.
