NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL BY-LAW DESIGNATING A PLACE OF ARCHITECTURAL VALUE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of The Corporation of the City of London intends to pass a by-law to repeal By-law No. L.S.P.-3156-244 (passed on September 8, 1992) which designates the following property as a place of architectural value or interest in accordance with the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*; it being pointed out that renovations to the building have significantly altered certain features of the house for which it had been designated:

Any person who objects to this intended repealing by-law must, within thirty days after the date of the first publication, serve on the City Clerk, a notice of objection in writing, setting out the reason for the objection and all relevant facts. The *Ontario Heritage Act* provides that where a notice of objection has been served, the Council shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
