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

A by-law to designate 777 Waterloo Street to be of architectural value.


WHEREAS pursuant to The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. 0.18, the Council of a municipality may by by-law designate a property including buildings and structures thereon to be of historic or architectural value or interest;


AND WHEREAS notice of intention to so designate the property known as 777 Waterloo Street has been duly published and served and no notice of objection to such designation has been received;

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural value or interest, the real property at 777 Waterloo Street, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto, for the reasons set out in Schedule "B" hereto.
2. The City Clerk is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered upon the title to the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper Land Registry Office.
3. The City Clerk is authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owner of the aforesaid property and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in the London Free Press, and to enter the description of the aforesaid property, the name and address of its registered owner, and short reasons for its designation in the Register of all properties designated under The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.
4. This by-law comes into force on the day it is passed.

Architectural Reasons

Exterior

The one and a half storey, white brick cottage was built in 1894. Typical of the Queen Anne style are its irregular outline, multiple gables, and tall decorated chimneys. The front façade features a large decorated gable with brackets. The original front double-leaf doors are extant; there is stained glass in the transoms above the front door and front round arch window. There is a three sided bay window at the side of the house.

Few alterations have been made to the original structure. There is a small frame addition at the rear, and the original fretwork porch has been removed.

Interior

The front entrance hall, living room and dining room contain a number of interesting features. A chandelier hangs from a plaster ceiling medallion with a fruit motif in the dining room. There is a fireplace composed of carved wood and tile in the living room. Most unusual is the carved starburst pattern corner blocks on the door and window frames, all finished in a painted finish.
