

AND IN THE MATTER OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES located on Part of Lot 3, Block 5, Plan 138, more particularly described as Parts 2 and 7 on Reference Plan 7R-2865, municipally known as 78 Broadway, in the Town of Orangeville, in the County of Dufferin, in the Province of Ontario.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Town of Orangeville intends to designate the building including lands on the premises located on Part of Lot 3, Block 5, Plan 138, more particularly described as Parts 2 and 7, Reference Plan 7R-2865, municipally known as 78 Broadway, in the Town of Orangeville, in the County of Dufferin, in the Province of Ontario.

REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION

The building at 78 Broadway represents the evolution of commercial architecture in Orangeville, having served as a hotel and more latterly, a retail outlet with accommodation above the store. The property owner has taken advantage of both phases of the Downtown Facade Improvement Program and the resulting work has stabilized and enhanced the facade of this c. 1864 structure.
