### NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Muskoka Lakes has passed by-law number 86-182 to repeal By-law 84-109, designating the following properties as being of historical value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337:

(a) Old Bala Hydro Plant, Concession A, Lot 14, Plan 26, Part of Lot 275, River Street, in the Geographic Town of Bala, now in the Township of Muskoka Lakes in the District Municipality of Muskoka, Province of Ontario, as it is the intent of Council to cause the Old Bala Hydro Plant to be re-established as an electric power producing facility or failing this to be removed from the property.

#### BY-LAW 84-109

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE OLD BALA HYDRO PLANT UNDER THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT.

PURSUANT TO THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, RSO, 1980, CHAPTER 337, COUNCIL MAY DESIGNATE THE LANDS AND BUILDINGS AS A PROPERTY OF HISTORICAL VALUE AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS the Council wishes to designate the Old Bala Hydro Plant being in Lot 14, Concession A, Plan 26, Part of Lot 275, River Street, Bala, now in The Township of Muskoka Lakes in the District Municipality of Muskoka.

AND WHEREAS the intention to designate was advertised commencing on the 29th day of August, 1984, in accordance with the Ontario Heritage Act for three consecutive weeks.

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection was served on the Clerk of the Municipality.

Now therefore The Corporation of The Township of Muskoka Lakes enacts as follows:

- That the Old Bala Hydro Plant in Concession A, Lot 14, Plan 26, part of Lot 275, River Street, Bala in the Corporation of The Township of Muskoka Lakes is hereby designated as a property of historical value and interest for the reasons attached hereto in Schedule "A".
- The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered in the Land Registry Office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.

### SCHEDULE "A"

#### TO BY-LAW NUMBER 84-109

#### HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

The Bala power generation station was built and began operation in 1917 and supplied power to the Port Carling, Bala, MacTier area under the Bala Electric Light and Power Company. In 1929 the station was purchased by Ontario Hydro and remained in operation until 1957. It is situated on the original inlet race of the Town's first saw mill built here in the 1880's, which runs through the centre of the community.
