NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg on the 13th day of June, 1983 established its intention to designate the land and building known municipally as 258 Mathew Street as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION:

"This white clapboard house is unique in Cobourg because of its "salt box" style. It has other good architectural features (front door, corner boards, roof cornice) which bespeak its early date, c.1840."

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Cobourg before the 8th day of August, 1983.
