BY-LAW No. 325-2008

To designate the Cabbagetown Northwest area as a heritage conservation district.

WHEREAS City Council has authorized the establishment of the Cabbagetown Northwest area as a Heritage Conservation District and has authorized the adoption of the Cabbagetown Northwest Heritage Conservation District Plan;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The area outlined by the heavy lines shown on the map attached as <u>Schedule</u> "A" to this by-law is designated as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18.
- 2. The heritage conservation district plan for the Cabbagetown Northwest Heritage Conservation District prepared by City of Toronto Heritage Preservation Services, dated August 2007 is adopted.
- 3. A copy of the heritage character statement and heritage conservation district plan is available for inspection at the office of Heritage Preservation Services, Planning Division, Suite A17, City Hall, 100 Queen Street West, Toronto, Ontario. It is also available on the City's website @ www.toronto.ca/heritage-preservation.


