NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 92-91

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg on the 20th day of January, 1992 established its intention to repeal by-laws designating various properties as being of architectural and historical value or interest, pursuant to the provisions of The Ontario Heritage Act, including By-law No. 92-91 effecting the property known municipally as Cobourg Lawn Bowling, 177 Church Street, Cobourg.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR REPEALING BY-LAW NO. 92-91

The Cobourg Municipal Council has enacted By-law No. 27-90, as amended by By-law No. 118-91, designating three heritage conservation districts and has submitted the By-law to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval, therefore, the Municipal Council proposes to repeal By-law No. 92-91.

The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 337, provides in part that no individual property designated by a council of a municipality under Part IV of the Act to be of architectural and/or historical value or interest, shall be designated as part of a heritage conservation district under Part V of the Act.

Notice of objection to the proposal to repeal By-law No. 92-91, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Cobourg before the 28th day of September, 1992.
