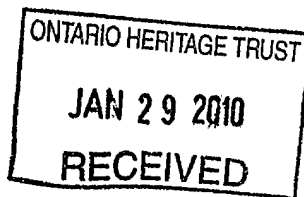

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL BY-LAW

185 Burnhamthorpe Road West

TAKE NOTICE that Oakville Town Council, on **January 25, 2010**, resolved to issue a notice of intention to repeal By-law **1992-237**, which designated **Part of Lot 17, Concession 2**, municipally known as **185 Burnhamthorpe Road West** under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. 18, as a property of cultural heritage value and interest.

Reason for Repeal of By-law 1992-237:

The owner applied to have the By-law repealed and this application was deemed to have been consented to pursuant to Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act.
