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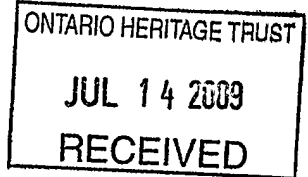

REMOVAL OF A DESIGNATED HERITAGE BUILDING

**PLAN M10 LOT 59,
municipally known as 144 Bronte Road, Oakville**



Take notice that Oakville Town Council, on April 27, 2009, resolved to approve Heritage Permit HP 12/09-42.20B, allowing the owner to remove the building located at 144 Bronte Road, a property which has been designated under Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. 18. The building is to be relocated to PLAN MB LOT 106, known municipally as 2389 Ontario Street, where it is to be conserved. Notwithstanding its relocation, the building will remain designated under the Ontario Heritage Act.
