NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REPEAL BY-LAW



144 Bronte Road, Oakville, Ontario Walton Memorial United Church Manse

On Tuesday, July 3, 2012, Oakville Town Council resolved to issue a notice of intention to repeal By-law 2010-108 for 144 Bronte Road, Oakville (PLAN M10 LOT 59) which designated the property as a property of cultural heritage value and interest under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. 18.

The notice of intention to repeal By-law 2010-108 has been issued because the historic house has been relocated from its original site at 144 Bronte Road to its new location at 39 Jones Street.
