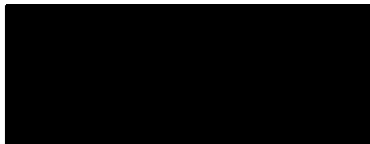

273 Burnhamthorpe Road East, Oakville, Ontario

Jones Farmhouse

TAKE NOTICE that on Monday, June 10, 2013, Oakville Town Council resolved to pass a Notice of Intention to Designate for 273 Burnhamthorpe Road East, Oakville (PT LT 13, CON 2 TRAFALGAR, NORTH OF DUNDAS STREET, PART 2, 20R4229; OAKVILLE/TRAFALGAR) under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. 18, as a property of cultural heritage value and interest.

The Jones Farmhouse is located in north Oakville at 273 Burnhamthorpe Road East on the northwest corner of Trafalgar Road and Burnhamthorpe Road East.

This property has historical and architectural value for its late 19<sup>th</sup> century farmhouse, a representative example of a vernacular frame farmhouse with Gothic Revival influences. The property is historically associated with the Jones and Campbell families, local farmers who owned the land, and with the agricultural development of Trafalgar Township. Contextually, the property is historically and functionally linked to the surrounding area and continues to be a reminder of rural life in Trafalgar Township.
