CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH

BY-LAW NO. 2457

A By-Law to designate a certain property within the Municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS Chapter 337 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, designate a property within the Municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate a certain property within the Municipality was served on the owner of the property and the Ontario Heritage Foundation, May 27th, 1982, and was published in the Perth Courier June 2nd, June 9th and June 16th, 1982.

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said property as a result of the aforementioned notices;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 The following property be and is hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

Description: The building and property at 37 Herriott Street located on Part of Lot No. 3 and Part of Lot No. 4 on the North side of Herriott Street, Plan 8828; and more particularly described in Schedule TAT attached hereto.

Owner:

Reason for Designation: The present structure is a $2\frac{1}{2}$ storey frame building built in 1860 on a square plan in the Italian or Luscan Style. Its appearance augmented by a classical style front porch, window shutters and sidelights with overhead transon surrounding a single panelled front entrance door. The main house is topped by a truncated hip roof, graced by a decorative bell-shaped dormer window, the caves decorated with dentil work and brackets. A $1\frac{1}{2}$ storey frame rear wing possess 6 over 6 pane windows.

This building is of visual significance to the total streetscape of the main streets of Perth, Ontario.

This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the passing thereof.
