BY-LAW NO. 2699

A By-Law To Designate A Certain Property  
Within The Municipality To Be Of Historic  
Or Architectural Value Or Interest

WHEREAS Chapter 337 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, designate a property within the Municipality to be of historical or architectural value or interest.

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate a certain property within the Municipality was served on the owner of the property and the Ontario Heritage Foundation, October 20, 1986 and was published in the Perth Courier October 22, October 29 and November 5, 1986.

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said property as a result of the aforementioned notices:

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following property be and is hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest:

Description: The Band Stand at 80 Gore Street East, lying and being in Part of Lot 2, Concession 1 in the Township of Drummond, in the County of Lanark and Province of Ontario, commonly known as Market Square and more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

Owner: The Corporation of the Town of Perth.

Reason For


Designation: The present structure forms an integral part of the downtown area and compliments stone buildings on Gore Street and the Stewart Park. The Band Stand was built in 1931 and consists of an octagon shaped wood roof structure supported on hollow, slender wood columns at the corners. The columns are supported on cut stone pedestals with a concrete floor slab and cut stone foundation walls. The roof is octagonal in shape with a straight pitched roof from peak to roof edge. The ceiling is to be generally parabolic shaped, curving downward toward the centre from the perimeter beams.

This structure is still being used for its original purpose, band concerts, and is of visual significance to the total streetscape of the main streets of Perth, Ontario.


2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the passing thereof.

ALL that Parcel or Tract of Land in the Town of Perth, in the County of Lanark and Province of Ontario, containing 0.83 of an acre (0.336 of a hectare), be the same more or less, being composed of that part of Lot 2, Concession 1, as shown on the plan of the Township of Drummond, commonly known as Market Square and shown as Market Site on the plan of the Town plot of Perth, of record in the Ministry of Natural Resources at Toronto, SAVING and EXCEPTING thereout and therefrom those parts of the said Market Square designated as Parts 2 and 4 on a plan of survey deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Lanark South as Plan 27R-2492.
