## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH BY-LAW 2870

A By-Law to designate certain properties within the Municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest

WHEREAS Chapter 337 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, designate properties within the Muncipality to be of historical or architectural value or interest.

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate certain properties within the Municipality was served on the owner of the properties and the Ontario Heritage Foundation, February 5, 1990 and was published in the Perth Courier February 14, February 21 and February 28, 1990.

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said properties as a result of the aforementioned notices:

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following properties be and are hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest:

Description: The Old Methodist Burying Ground on Robinson Street lying between Robinson and Halton Streets, being Part of Lot 10 on the North side of Robinson Street on Plan 8828.

Owner: St. Paul's United Church.

REASON FOR DESIGNATION:

This cemetery was incorporated in 1843. The gravestones and fences at the site are in need of major repairs.

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the passing thereof.

READ a first, second and third time and passed this twenty-seventh day of March, 1990.
