## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH

## **BY-LAW NO. 3404**

Being a By-law to designate certain property within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS Chapter 0.18 Ontario Heritage Act, RSO 1990 provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, designate property within the Municipality to be of historical or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate a certain property within the Municipality was served on the owner of the property and the Ontario Heritage Foundation, on July 5<sup>th</sup> 2001, and was published in the Perth Courier July 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> 2001;

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said property as a result of the aforementioned notices:

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth hereby enacts as follows:

1. The following property be and is hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest:
