**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Montague intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 761 William Campbell Road as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under the Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 c. O.18.

#### Reasons for Proposed Designation

Our research into the Church and Orange Hall reveal that the Orange Hall is the original Church in Montague Township circa 1890. Christ Church was built later (circa 1900) which also then became the only church in Montague Township for a large number of years. Many of the forefathers of Montague helped to build both the Hall and Church and it has become a part of the Township's heritage.

The following items have been deemed to be original in both buildings and thus are an architectural value in nature:

1. The Stained Glass Window in the Church
2. Leaded Windows in the Church
3. Window Sills in the Church
4. Floor in the Church
5. Pews in the Church
6. The Brick work on the outside of the Church
7. The Brick work on the outside of the Orange Hall
8. The Ceiling and Floor in the Orange Hall
9. The Wainscoting in the Orange Hall
