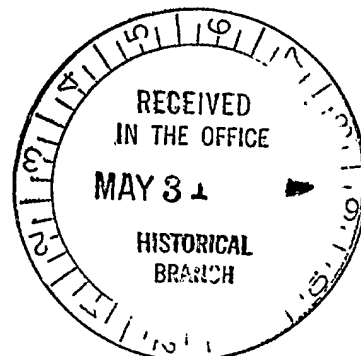

N O T I C E   O F   I N T E N T I O N

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Corporation of the Township of Lobo intends to designate the following property to be of historical value or interest within the meaning of the Ontario Heritage Act, Statutes of Ontario, 1974, Chapter 122, Section 29, namely;

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, laying and being in the Township of Lobo, in the County of Middlesex, and being composed of that Part of Lot Number 7, in the Ninth Concession of the said Township.

THE MARSH STORE situated in the Village of Coldstream, Ontario, is recommended for historical designation as a good example of architectural construction of the early 1800's. The building is a local landmark, important to the area as it was used as a General Store, Post Office, Library, Council Chambers for the Township of Lobo, Marsh Telephone System and for a continuation school for grades 10 - 12.

We feel that it is a historical site worth preserving.

Notice of Objection to the designation may be served upon the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Lobo, on or before the 10th day of February, 1976.
