THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOBO

BY-LAW NO. 53-77

WHEREAS the Marsh Store situate in the Hamlet of Coldstream, Ontario, is a landmark of historical importance, it having been used for the General Store, Post Office, Library, Council Chambers for the Township of Lobo, the Marsh Telephone System and for a Continuation School since the early 1800's and it is an excellent example of architectural construction of the early 1800's;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the Township of Lobo is desirous of designating the property known as the Marsh Store to be of historical value or interest within the meaning of The Heritage Act, Statutes of Ontario, 1974, Chapter 122, Section 29;

AND WHEREAS Notice of Intention to so designate such property has been served and published pursuant to The Heritage Act and no Notice of Objection thereto has been received.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a By-law as follows:

1. THAT the property known as the Marsh Store in the Hamlet of Coldstream, being composed of those portions of Lot 7, in the 9th Concession of the Township of Lobo, in the County of Middlesex, designated as Parts 1 and 2 according to Reference Plan 33R2387 be designated to be of historical value or interest within the meaning of The Ontario Heritage Act.

This By-law shall become effective upon the passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and passed this 7th

day of November, 1977.
