NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE



TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Nanticoke intends to designate the properties, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal addresses, as properties of architectural and/or historical value or interest, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

- (a) Part of Lot 24, Concession 1, in the former Township of Townsend, now in the City of Nanticoke, in the Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk. The property, known as the Upper Farm Cemetery - City of Nanticoke, Townsend Cemetery, is a small, rural cemetery, which is now part of the 20th Century Townsend development, and is representative of 19th Century Ontario graveyards. Twenty-one white slab markers have survived the passage of time, ranging in date from 1842 to 1873.
- (b) Lot 19, Concession 2, in the former Township of Walpole, now in the City of Nanticoke, in the Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk. The property, known as the S.S. #2, Walpole School - Wilson Pugsley MacDonald Memorial School Museum, is a tribute to the poet, Wilson MacDonald, and also to the early days of education. The building is representative of the small, one-room schools which are fast disappearing from our countryside.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts, may be served on the Clerk of the City of Nanticoke before the 30th day of July, 1982.
